

OMAKASE COURSE MENU コース料理

We offer 3 different omakase menus, named after the Three Sacred Treasures of Japan (三種の神器); the sword Kusanagi no Tsurugi (草薙劍), the jewel Yasakani no Magatama (八尺瓊勾玉), and the mirror; Yata no Kagami (八咫鏡),

According to legend, these treasures were brought to earth by Ninigi-no-Mikoto, legendary ancestor of the Japanese imperial line, when his grandmother, the sun goddess Amaterasu, sent him to pacify Japan. These treasures were eventually said to be passed down to Emperor Jimmu, who was the first Emperor of Japan and was also Ninigi's great-grandson. Traditionally, they were a symbol of the emperor's divinity as a descendant of Amaterasu, confirming his legitimacy as ruler.

TSURUGI 剣

The Kusanagi no Tsurugi (草薙の剣) is a legendary Japanese sword said to be discovered by Susanoo, the God of the seas, when he slew open the fearsome eight-headed dragon Yamata no Orochi. The sword represents the virtue of valour, and is believed to be kept at Atsuta Shrine, in Nagoya.

MAGATAMA **勾玉**

The Yasakani no Magatama (八尺瓊勾玉) is a piece of jewelry, said to be made of jade, that was used alongside the Yata no Kagami to lure the Goddess Amaterasu out of her cave.

The jewel represents the virtue of compassion, and is reportedly housed in the

Three Palace Sanctuaries, Tokyo.

KAGAMI 鏡

The Yata no Kagami (八咫鏡) is a sacred mirror in Shintoism. According to legend, Ame-no-Uzume, the Goddess of Dawn, used the mirror to lure Amaterasu, the Sun Goddess, out of a cave which she locked herself in after a furious argument with her brother, Susanoo. The mirror represents the virtue of wisdom, and it is believed to reveal the true nature of whoever looks into it. It is purportedly stored at the Ise Grand Shrine, in Mie Prefecture.
